The 2018 Idaho Artistry in Wood Show is fast approaching. To facilitate the participation of club members we are providing some special arrangements and incentives. Club members who are current with their dues will receive free entry of their first piece registered and delivered in advance. We will have copies of the prospectus to consult and registration forms for your use at the February club meeting. Our March club meeting will be advance registration night for the show. You can bring your entries and registration forms to the March 8 meeting at Woodcraft and avoid the necessity of taking them to JUMP on show registration day. Members of the IWG board will see that they get to the show for judging on March 16. We will not be able to accept large, heavy or highly fragile pieces which would be difficult for us to transport to the show, but most carvings and pyrography pieces should be fine.

As previously announced, we will provide instruction sessions for those who would like to do a carving from roughouts.com. Just go to the roughouts.com website, choose the roughout(s) you would like to order and bring a check or cash for the price of the piece plus \$2 for shipping to our February meeting.
