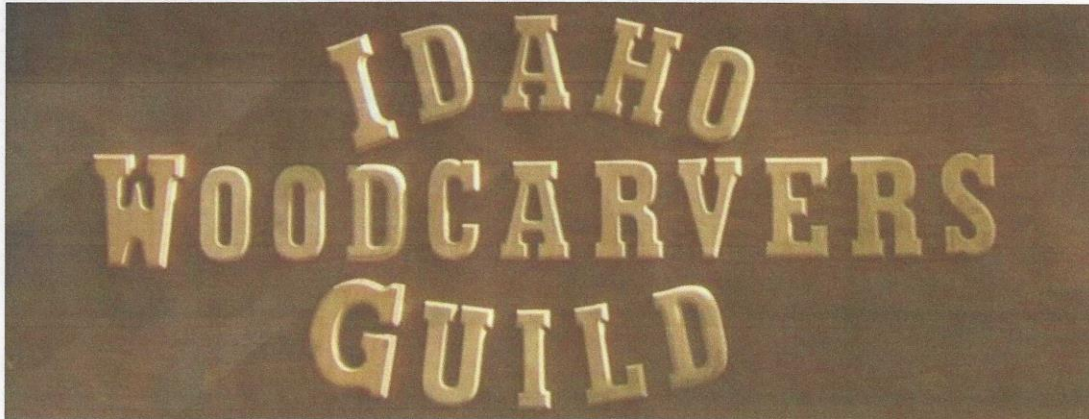




Our Guild meets the second Thursday of each month all year round at 6:00 P.M. at the Woodcraft Store located in the Overland Park Shopping Center at :
