Minutes from the March 12, 2020 Meeting

President Larry Crist called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

Attendance: About 24, including two first time attendees

Larry announced that there were two principal areas of focus for the meeting: Registration for the Idaho Artistry in Wood Show and Judging of entries in the "President's Challenge" carving contest by a special guest who would arrive shortly.

Members were invited to bring their entries for the Artistry in Wood Show to the front table, complete registration forms and check in their works. By the end of the evening pre-registrations for the show from mail or the meeting reached more than 50 carvings or pyrography pieces.

Entries in the President's Challenge contest were separated into skill levels. Larry then introduced the special judge for the event, past IWG President and member emeritus of the Caricature Carvers of America, Vic Otto, who was warmly welcomed. After making his selections of honorable mention, third, second and first place in each skill level, Vic used the opportunity to show how each of the entries met judging criteria and could have been improved, providing an excellent learning opportunity for those in attendance. Larry then awarded cash prizes to the winners and hand-crafted carving knife to those who earned first place.

The business completed, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
