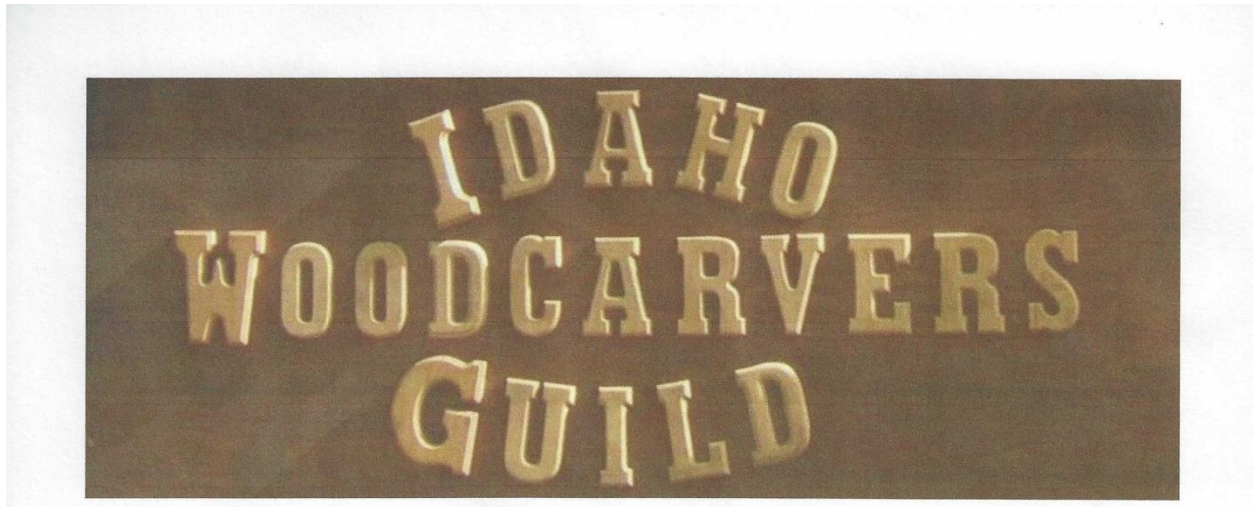

The Idaho Artistry in Wood 2022 Wood and Gourd Art Show will be held at the JUMP (Jack's Urban Meeting Place) exhibition hall, 1000 W. Myrtle, Boise, ID 83702 on Saturday, April 2 and Sunday, April 3. Show hours on Saturday are 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. and on Sunday, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

The cost of entering work in the show is \$3.00 per piece if registered in advance or \$5.00 at registration, which will take place Friday, April 1, 12-6 p.m. at the exhibition hall on the 5th floor.
