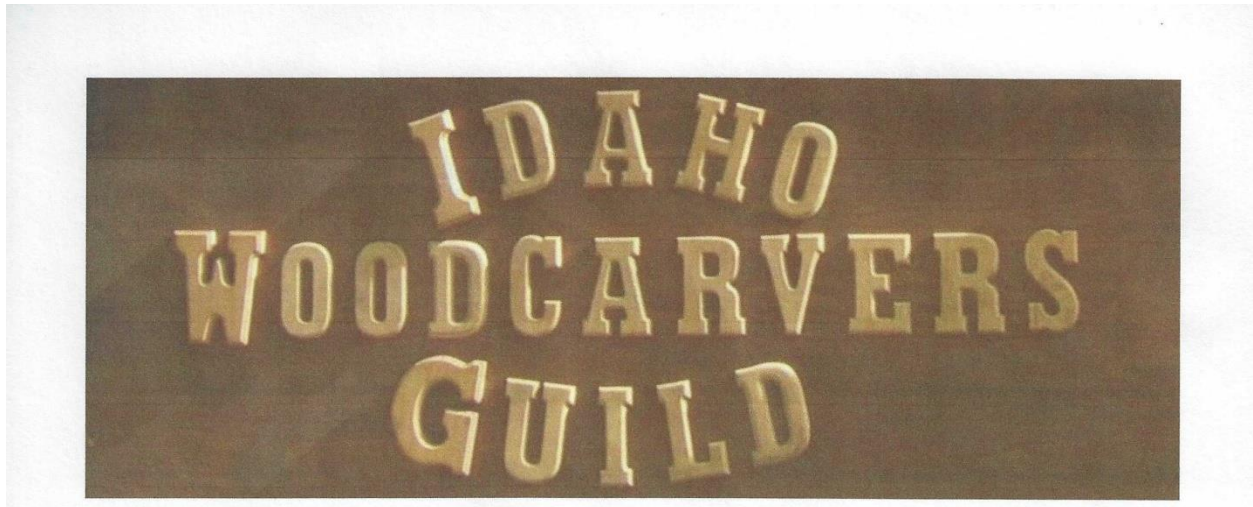

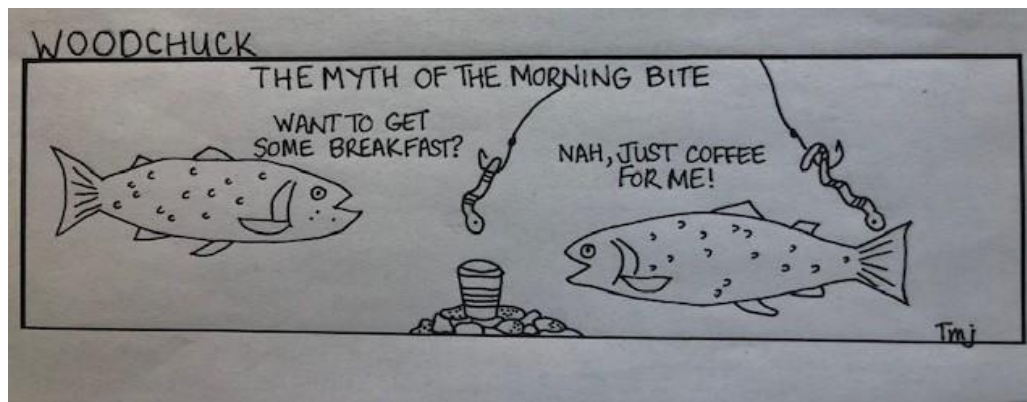
CLASSES

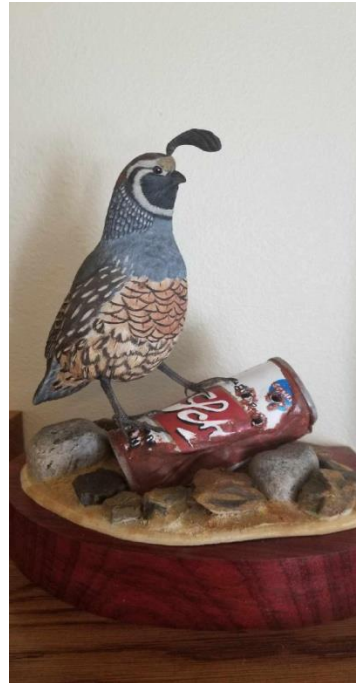
